## YOU ARE NOT ALONE. THE FACTS ON DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

- Every 9 seconds in the U.S. a woman is assaulted or beaten.¹
- Around the world, at least one in every three women has been beaten, coerced into sex or otherwise abused during her lifetime. Most often, the abuser is a member of her own family.2
- **64 percent of women** who reported being raped, physically assaulted, and/or stalked since age 18 were victimized by a current or former husband, cohabitating partner, boyfriend or date.3
- Domestic violence is the leading cause of injury to women more than car accidents, muggings and rapes combined.4
- In a national survey of more than 6,000 American families, 50 percent of the men who frequently assaulted their wives also frequently abused their children.5
- Studies suggest that up to 10 million children witness some form of domestic violence annually.6
- 80% of runaways come from homes where domestic violence occurs.<sup>7</sup>
- **40 percent of girls** age 14 to 17 report knowing someone their age who has been hit or beaten by a boyfriend.8
- 94 percent of men in jail are witnesses or victims of domestic violence.9
- 92 percent of women surveyed listed reducing domestic violence and sexual assault as their top concern.10

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
