18,000+ children and teens are injured or killed each year due to gun violence.

IF THE ANSWER IS

that's one less thing you have to worry about. ASK: Is there an unlocked gun where my child plays?



If there are any doubts about the safety of another home, invite the kids to your house instead. IF THE ANSWER IS "YES"

make sure all guns are stored unloaded and locked, ideally in a gun safe, with ammunition locked separately.



Hiding guns is not enough. Just talking to kids is not enough. Kids are curious and if they find guns they're likely to play with them.
