
Quarterly Statistical Report – Year to Date December 2011

Domestic-related call events (domestic disturbance, domestic battery, and violation order of protection) declined by 4.5% from 2010 to 2011 (197,798 vs. 188,977, -8,821). Chicago averaged 518 domestic call events daily or 20.7 per district. Only Districts 01 (+28) and 22 (+47) had increases for the year; District 07 had the largest absolute decline (-1,604, -8.4%).

Reported domestic incidents declined by 4.9% from 2010 to 2011 (56,962 vs. 54,189, -2,773) for a daily average of 148 in 2011. Districts 04, 11, 14, 19, and 21 had increases of less than 4.0% each; District 07 had the greatest absolute decrease (-458, -9.5%) but also accounted for the greatest number of domestic incidents (4,378 or 8.1% of domestic incidents). District 19 had the fewest domestic incidents (421 or 0.8% of citywide domestic incidents).


Arrests for simple domestic batteries decreased from 2010 to 2011 by 558 or -7.1% (7,895 vs. 7,337); aggravated domestic battery arrests decreased from 74 to 65 (-9, -12.2%), and violation of an order of protection arrests slid from 673 to 618 (-55, -8.2%). Total arrests citywide declined from 167,564 to 152,751 (-14,813, -8.8%).

Domestic-Related Call Events Per Day by District *




* Numbers in the map represent the 25 CPD districts

Average number of Domestic Disturbance, Domestic Battery, and Violation of Order of Protection call events per day.




Domestic-Related Call Events By Day Of Week




Total Domestic-Related Calls = 188,977 YTD - December 2011

Total Domestic Crimes = 54,189 YTD - December 2011



Quarterly Domestic Violence Summary

Of the 433 total murders in Chicago in 2011, detectives coded 17 as general domestic and nine as child abuse compared to 2010 when there were 30 general domestic murders and also nine child abuse murders of the 436 total murders. During 2011, 58.8% of general domestic murders and 44.4% of child abuse murders in Chicago occurred in districts that averaged 1 - 19 domestic-related calls events daily.

In 2011, of the child abuse murder victims four were females and five were males, six were black, two were white, and one was hispanic; the offenders were four fathers, four mothers, and two mother's paramour, ages of 19 to 54. Ten of the general domestic murder victims were females and seven were males, 11 were black, four were hispanic, and two were white. The offender relationships were four girlfriends, three boyfriends, two "none", and one each of ex-boyfriend, ex-girlfriend, ex-husband, father, son, brother, grandson, and "not established".

Domestic Violence and Child Abuse Murders By Weapon Type YTD - December 2011




Domestic Violence and Child Abuse Murders By Day of Injury YTD - December 2011


