WHERE: All events originate in HemisFair Arch plaza.

WHY: Domestic & sexual violence is often a difficult subject to discuss, especially when it happens close to home, but this unique event **celebrates local empowerment through the power of dance & self-expression**.

San Antonio joins hundreds of thousands of individuals worldwide on this 15th Anniversary of VDAY. We RISE because worldwide, one in three women will be beaten or raped in her lifetime, and one billion women hurt is an **atrocity**. But one billion women & men dancing is a **revolution**, and we hope to bring that change to our city.

The San Antonio community will be invited to learn the "Break the Chain" dance through online tutorials, and join us for the FlashMob. Dancers and passers-by alike will be invited to stay throughout the evening, and strike, rise, and dance with us in protest of violence against women and girls.
