PRO BONO ATTORNEY PROGRAM - We help victims of domestic violence and sexual assault with free legal representation in civil cases.

INFORMATION AND REFERRAL HOTLINE - We have a monthly information and referral hotline to answer basic questions about legal rights and options for victims.

CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION CONFERENCE - We host a free annual conference to train volunteer attorneys, legal advocates, child custody investigators and more. We provide mentoring, training and supervision.

PUBLICATIONS TO HELP ATTORNEY'S HELP VICTIMS - We publish the Family Law Practice Manual, with form pleadings and case law analysis, and other publications. Our lending library has more than 300 other resources available free of charge to attorneys.

PARTNERSHIP WITH ALASKA IMMIGRATION JUSTICE PROJECT - In partnership with AIJP, we provide integrated holistic family and immigration legal services, trained interpreters and culturally and linguistically appropriate services.

What We Do

The ANDVSA Legal Advocacy Project provides free direct representation to low-income victims of domestic violence and sexual assault in divorce, child custody and protective order proceedings using both staff attorneys and volunteers.

We are the largest and most successful network of pro bono attorneys in Alaska helping victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.

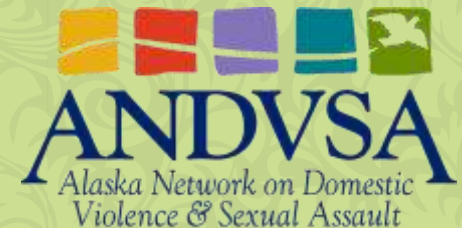
We provide training to participating pro bono attorneys on family law and domestic violence and sexual assault issues.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q What is the ANDVSA Legal Advocacy Project Pro Bono Program?

A The ANDVSA Pro Bono Program helps victims of domestic violence and sexual assault receive free direct representation in civil legal cases, including divorce, child custody and protective orders. We have the largest network of pro-bono attorneys in Alaska.

Q How does the Pro Bono Program help me if I become a volunteer attorney?

A The Pro Bono Program has experienced staff attorneys to provide mentoring, training and supervision. We provide a free Continuing Legal Education annual conference for all volunteers, and we provide malpractice coverage.

Q How do I get involved in your Continuing Legal Education Conference? Is there a cost?

A Our annual CLE conference is free for all volunteer attorneys taking a case. We provide free travel, accommodations and training materials to attendees, who receive CLE credit.

Q What if I am working with a limited English proficient victim?

A Our unique partnership with the Alaska Immigration Justice Project provides trained interpreters in order to assure that the rights of rural underserved populations including immigrants and Alaska Natives are protected.
