This session will provide an overview of current research and practices with internet sex offenders. The talk focuses mostly on child pornography offenders, but also discusses emerging work on offenders who use internet technologies to communicate with and sexually solicit minors. We will cover the ways that internet offenders are similar to, and differ from, typical contact offenders, describe the risk factors that have been identified in follow-up research, and discuss how this research informs treatment and management strategies.

Policy for Training Registrants Who Fail to Cancel **Updated 02-19-13**

The Sex Offender Management Unit (SOMU) at the Division of Criminal Justice within the Colorado Department of Public Safety has recently identified a problem with individuals who register for SOMU-sponsored training events but then neither attend the training events nor call with sufficient notice to cancel their registration. This is a problem because SOMU training events are often full and have a wait-list of individuals who could attend if the registered trainee gave sufficient notice to cancel their registration. As a result, individuals who could attend training events are deprived of a place in the training and SOMU training events are often not full to capacity. The SOMU goes to great effort to provide trainings at reduced rates or no charge. "No Shows" are greatly impacting our ability to do this.

Based upon the above, the SOMU has established the following new policy:

If an individual registers for a training event but neither attends said training nor cancels within 48 hours of the scheduled training barring unforeseeable circumstances (e.g., death, medical emergency, etc.), the individual will be placed at the end of the registration lists (behind attendees and any wait list) for the next training event they wish to register for. The individual will be notified of the missed training event and the resulting sanction via email.

If an individual registers but neither attends, nor cancels within 48 hours of the scheduled training barring unforeseeable circumstances (e.g., death, medical emergency, etc.) for a second time the individual will be placed at the end of the registration list for all remaining training events within the Fiscal Year. The individual will be notified of the 2nd missed training event and the resulting sanction via email.

Cancellations will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
