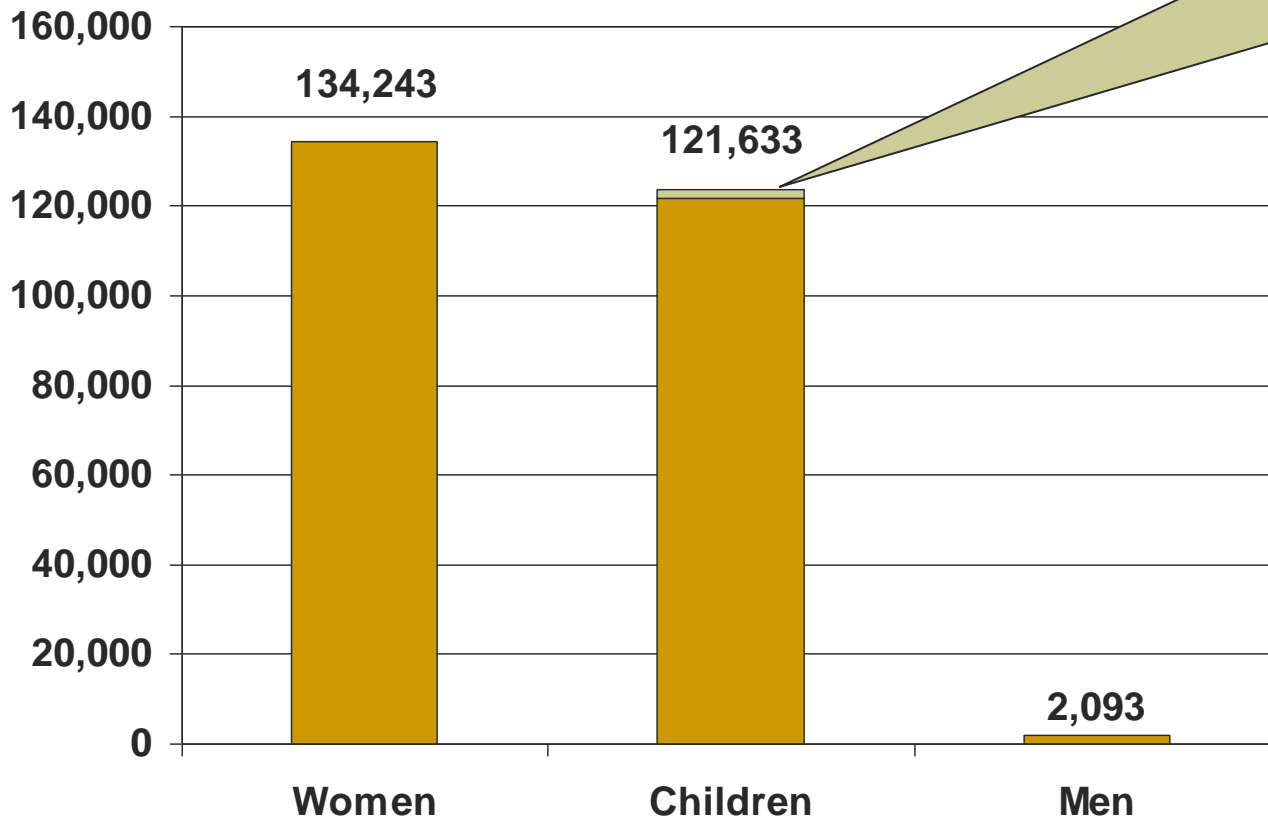

[FY 2010 FVPSA State Funding]

- \$86,548,071 awarded to local programs
- FVPSA funds supported
 - 1,533 shelters
 - 966 non-residential service sites

2010 Residential Services

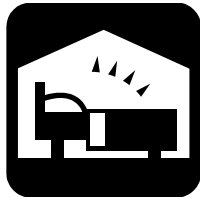
People receiving shelter services in residential facility, hotel, safehome or other

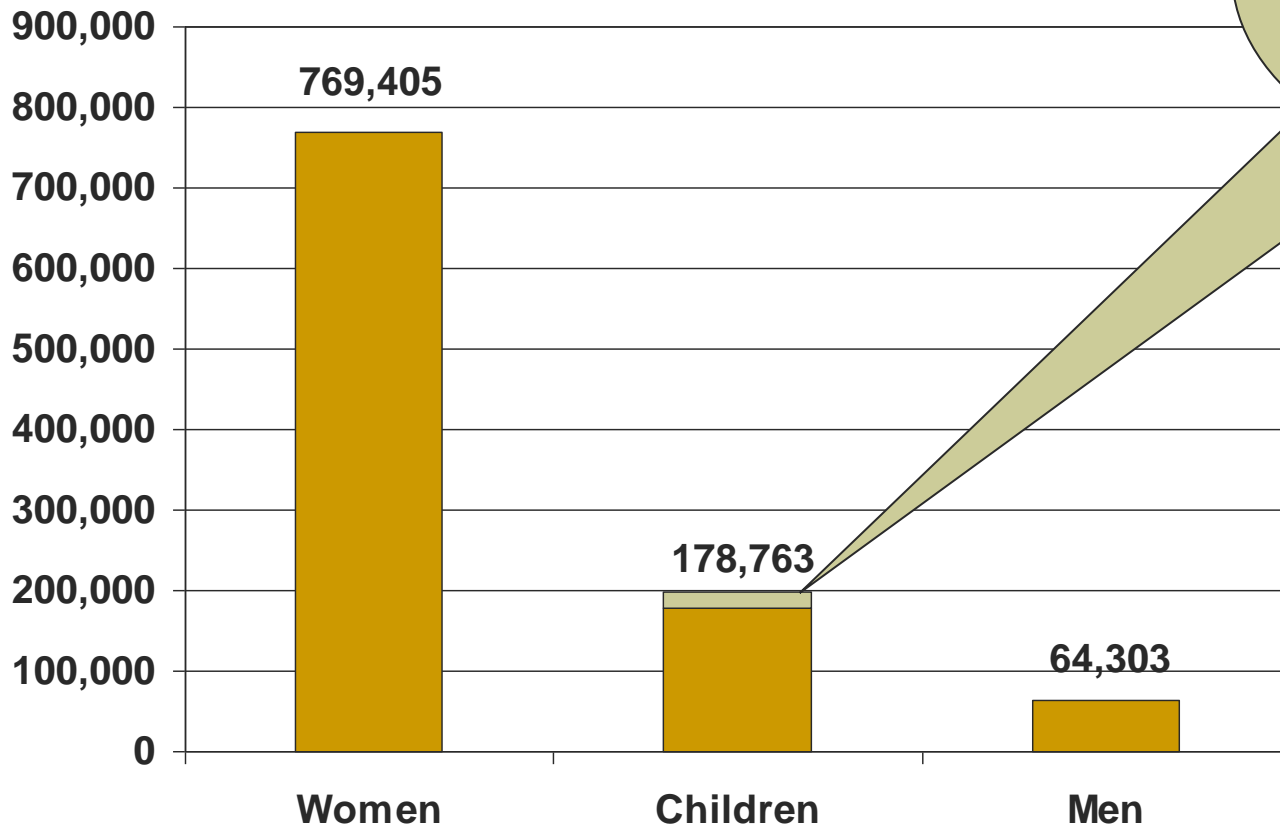
8,325,699 shelter nights provided

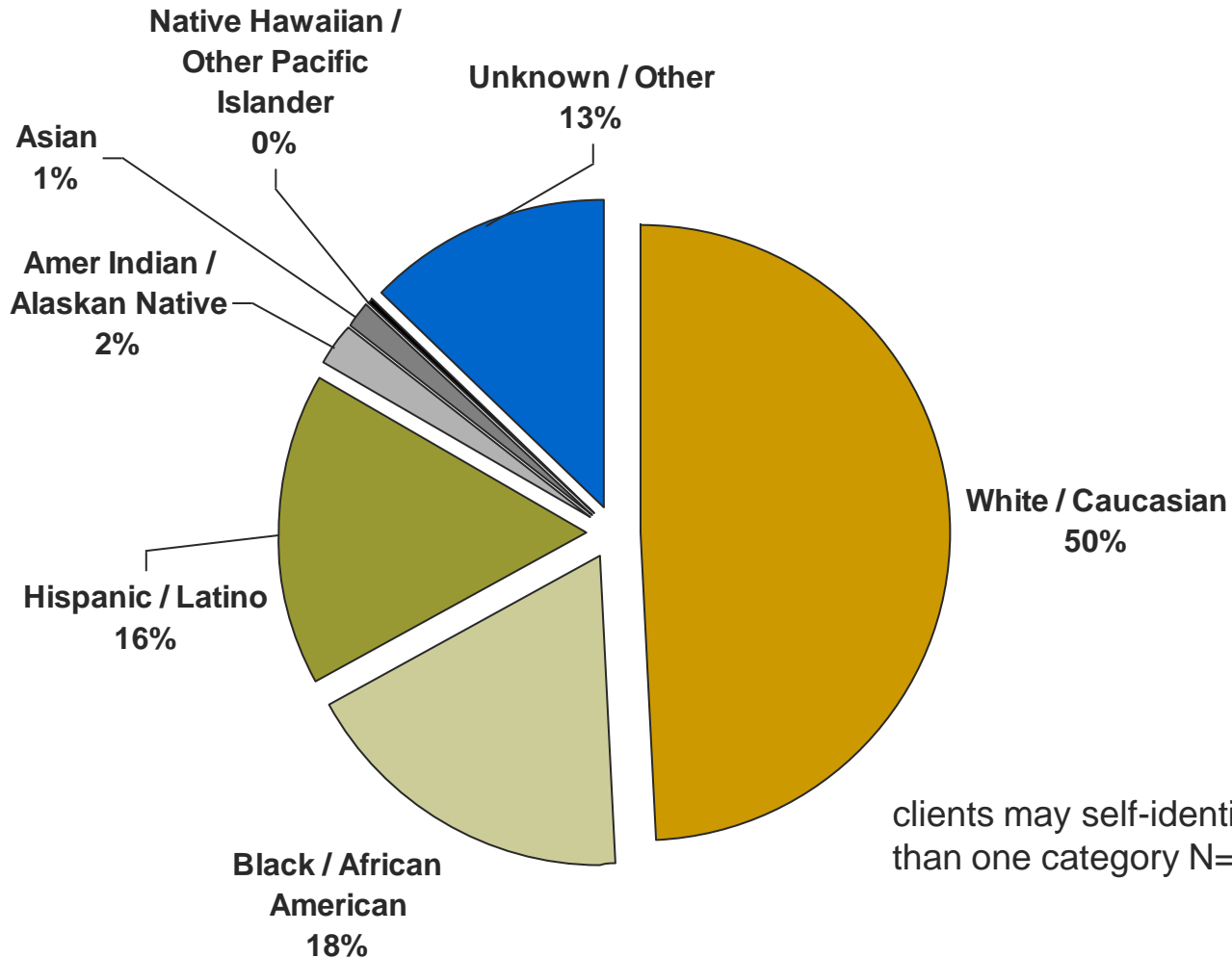

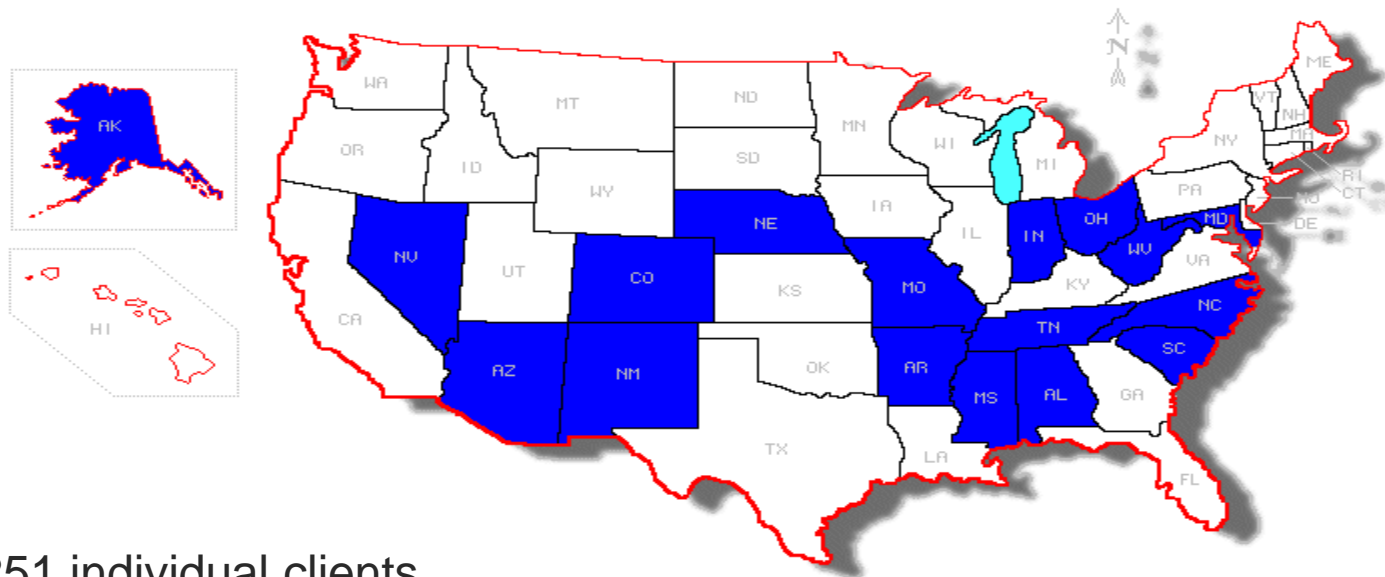
