Founding Fathers Against Violence

To mark Mother's Day, for the first time ever, a diverse and powerful group of men went to Washington, D.C. earlier this month to advocate for measures to stop violence against women and children. These founding fathers urged lawmakers to support prevention initiatives in the Violence Against Women Act, which will be reauthorized by Congress next year. Organized by the Family Violence Prevention Fund (FVPPF), the men attended a briefing sponsored by Senators Orrin Hatch (R-UT) and Joseph Biden (D-DE), and as well as a luncheon sponsored by Lifetime Television, the Congressional Caucus for Women's Issues and the Congressional Asian Pacific American Caucus.
