† The FY 2011 Congressional appropriation for CDC included a reduction to CDC's base funding of \$740 million. CDC cut the Rape Prevention and Education Program by \$3.1 million as part of its FY 2011 operating plan submitted in accordance with the FY 2011 Congressional appropriation.

≠ The Violence Against Women Health Initiative, previously the Training for Health Professionals (HRSA) and Public Health Responses to Abuse (CDC) programs, is administered through the Office of Women's Health.

± The L-HHS programs were reduced by a 0.189% across the board cut for FY '12.
