Volunteer Management Certification (VMC)

Volunteers are the backbone of many sexual assault service providers. As funding sources dwindle and services broaden, it is likely that volunteers will play an even larger part in the continuum of services for victims of sexual violence. TAASA is offering an opportunity to enhance and broaden your knowledge and expertise, thus making volunteer managers or coordinators of greater value to any agency's direct services for sexual violence survivors, community outreach and education.

The VMC Program consists of 30 hours of approved classes, taken at your convenience over a three-year span (starting with the date of your first class). Participants must complete a total of 30 hours of training (24 core hours + six elective hours), and successfully submit an 800-1000 word essay to receive TAASA's Volunteer Management Certificate. Applicants or their sponsoring agency must be a TAASA member to participate in the Volunteer Management Certification program.
