Tabu's Rape Awareness Video Project

Applicants are asked to produce a video project (10 minutes or less) that would demonstrate the urgent need for sexual violence awareness. The deadline is 11:59 p.m. (EST) Wednesday, June 1, 2011.

Who is Eligible?

The project is open to young people (age 16-25) who are currently not paid professionals in their field, or deriving significant income as a freelancer. Multiple persons can apply as a team but only one grant will be awarded and to be split among applicants.

All entries must be original work and must have been created or first published within the last 12 months.

What's the Prize?

The winning project will receive a grand prize grant award of \$1,000, feature on Tabu's website and included on a resource DVD distributed to sexual assault awareness groups.

Two awards of excellence will receive a grant of \$250 and will be featured on our website.
