Position Title: Violence Prevention Education Specialist

Reports To: Violence Free Coalition (VFC) Director

Type of Position: Part-time and Hourly (24 hr/wk)

Duties:

1. Research “Best and Promising” practice curriculums on violence prevention.
2. Implement and coordinate the RE-Do (Respect Everyone Despite Odds) Day Challenge – a character education program designed to reveal that what we share is greater than that which separates us-, Safe Dates and Second Step bullying prevention curriculum to designated area schools.
3. Promotes proactive responses to violence prevention with youth groups such as the Stand for Peace Clubs formed at the schools that host Re-Do Challenge Day.
4. Administer pre/post surveys to students and measure outcomes of our prevention education programs. Analyze and summarize results from data entered into Survey Monkey. Lead and provide technical support to schools implementing Re-Do follow-up sessions.
5. Assists Violence Prevention Education Coordinator in needs assessment and Teen Dating Violence classroom activities as needed.
6. Performs other related duties for Violence Free Coalition. Incumbent must be available for all agency meetings and record minutes at all VFC meetings.

Qualifications:

1. Possess a BS/BA in Education and/or Psychology or Social Services and at least two years related work or internship experience.
2. Experience in providing groups and/or teaching youth or adults.
3. Ability to communicate and positively influence and connect with K-12 school students.
4. Proficient with all Microsoft Office operating systems, survey monkey and the latest social media networks, also must possess the ability to handle multiple priorities.
5. Valid Ohio Driver’s License with a good driving record.
